Governance

- Controlling the net for social reasons:
 - Security (reporting, fixing, identification)
 - Privacy (individual)
 - Secrecy (organizational)
 - Copyright
 - Censorship (pornography, slander, bullying, seditious speech)

Three kinds of conflict

- Regulation doesn't match architecture
 - No clear “controller”; mashups, multiple players
- Conflicting requirements
 - Security & Privacy
 - Law enforcement, determining responsibility
- Jurisdictional mismatch
